Dear Sir/Madam,

Could you ensure that all of your gas and electric cards are at the office by Monday 5th December 2011. If they are not here on this day then they may not be ready for collection.

You can collect the cards on Thursday 8th December 2011.

As the office will be closed for some days over Christmas and New Year we will be putting £120 on the gas card and £90 on the electric card.

These cards then need to be brought back to the office on Monday 9th January 2012 to be collected on Thursday 12th January 2012. This will then start again every 2 weeks.
